Urgent Crown Development application – MOD Bicester (Site A)

I am writing on behalf of residents across my constituency regarding the status of the proposed Urgent Crown Development application for MOD Bicester (Site A).

On 13 July, I was notified that the Government was intending to pursue this urgent route. Despite this, and after 24 days, the application is yet to be published.

I would therefore be grateful if you could provide copies of:

- the Urgent Crown Development application;
- the planning statement and any supporting planning assessment;
- any transport, heritage, environmental, habitat, flood risk or any other technical assessments that have been conducted;
- any Equality Impact Assessment;
- any responses to the consultation that have been received to date; and
- any correspondence between the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government and the Home Office regarding the application

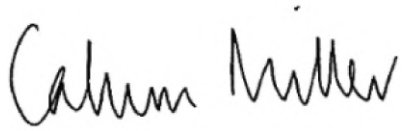
I would also be grateful if you could confirm, without delay:

- the date on which the application was submitted;
- whether it was submitted as an urgent application, notwithstanding the reference to "Section 293D applications" in your letter of 13 July;
- the application's current status; and
- that no final decision has yet been taken by the Secretary of State

Due to the significant concern among local residents, I would be grateful of a response and publication of these documents as soon as possible.
